

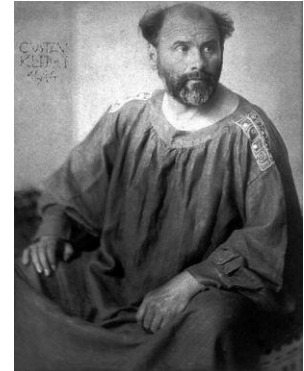
Gustav Klimt

Born in Austria on 14th July 1862

He is well known for his murals and paintings.

Described as a bit of a homebody and liked to wear sandals and a loose robe!

He loved using metallic colours and his pictures are really detailed.



Let's have a go...

*We can re-create the iconic image - **Adele Bloch-Bauer I***



For this activity you will need black paper and gold or silver marker pens.

Cut out a picture from a magazine or newspaper of a face – draw the dress – add lots of detail.



Create a detailed background using shapes and mark making.



If you don't have gold and silver pens you could use white paper and a black marker and re-create the dress using lots of different mark making.

Try painting your own *Tree of life*.

See if you can create the same swirls and shapes as Klimt.

Draw a simple outline and then add lots of swirly detail.



Use a black marker pen to create lots of detailed mark making to build up a tree.
