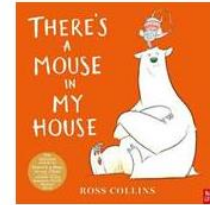

Author: Rachel Bright **Illustrator:** Nadia Shireen

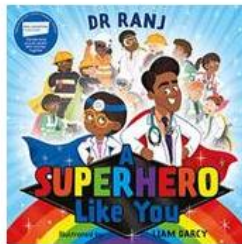
Doug is a slug in need of a hug... but no-one wants to give him a cuddle! Will Doug ever find his perfect match? A brilliantly fun read.

Author: Ross Collins

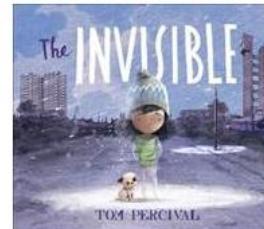
