

The Three Bears song



Here is an action song for The Three bears. They are walking back home to see if their porridge has cooled down. Daddy bear has big steps that last a long time. Mummy bear's steps are in the middle, and Baby bear has small steps. She finds it hard to keep up with her parents!

Here is their family walking song:

Daddy Bear he walks like this, *Taaa*

(Big long step)

Mummy Bear she walks like this, *Taa-Taa*

(Medium steps)

Baby Bear she walks like this, *Ti-Ti-Ti-Ti*

(Small quick steps)

Challenge:

Can you use some teddies to help you do the different steps around your room or garden as you sing?

How about having a go at making a bear mask or puppets for the song?

Can you use the bear paw prints and musical notes to make a sequence of different ways the bears walk home?

What rhythm of footsteps could Goldilocks make?

Here are some bear paw prints and notations to help create a musical sequence and repeating patterns.

Taaa steps last for 4 claps for the whole 'taaa'

Taa-taa steps last for 2 claps for each 'taa'

Ti-ti-ti-ti steps are 1 clap for each 'ti'
