On Thursday, we had two netball teams participating in matches. The Y5/6 mixed team played in a tournament at St Michael's School and got better and better as the games progressed.

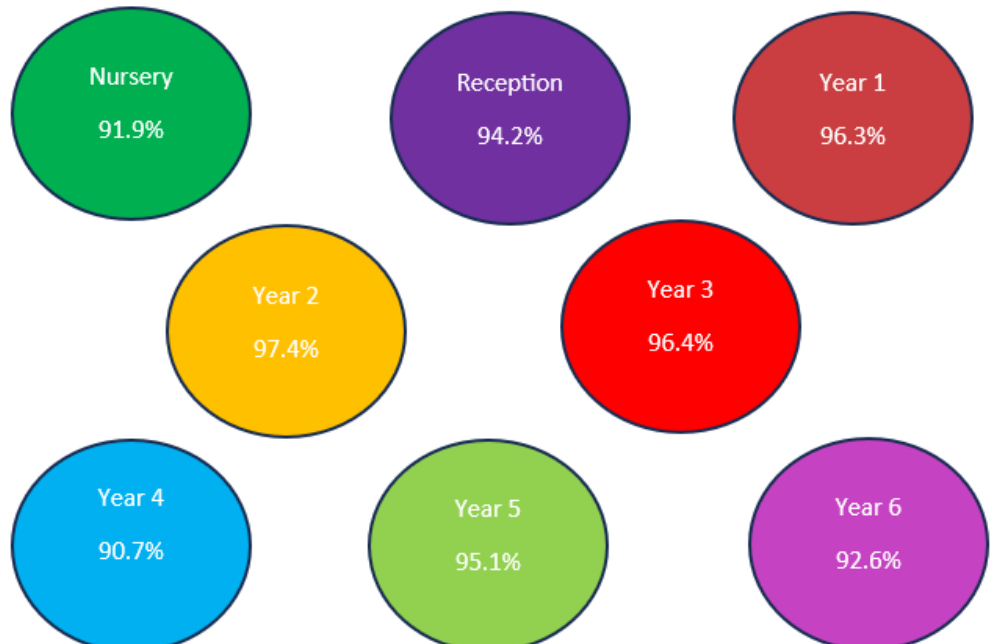
St Mary's hosted Haddenham School in a Year 5 mixed tournament and although we lost 2-1, the improvement in the children's skill level was phenomenal.
