One of our school values is 'Integrity'. Can you create an acrostic poem poster showing what this value means to you - we will try and display as many as we can!

Writing Challenge*:

We would like you to write a book review about a book of your choice. This could include:

- Title and Author of your book.
- Why you like this book.
- Your favourite part of the book and why.
- A star review out of 5.

We will use your book review to create a Year 2 Book Recommendation list for the school website!

Extra Challenge: Write a sentence to tell us who your book would be suitable for.

Maths Challenge*:

Play a game with someone at home. Roll two dice and add the numbers together. Multiply that number by either 2, 5 or 10 and record your calculations.

Extra Challenge: Can you link any of your calculations to division facts.

E.g. $2 \times 5 = 10$ so $10 \div 2 = 5$

Reading Challenge:

We love reading! We also love hearing about your favourite place to read! Can you take (or draw) a picture of yourself reading your favourite book (maybe the one you write a book review about) in your most favourite place to read it?

Can you add a sentence to explain why it is your favourite place to read?

Science Challenge:

We are learning all about animals, including humans in Science this half term. We would like you to pick an animal and create a poster or fact file to share some information with us.

You could include facts about where it lives? What it eats? What it looks like? What its babies are called?

Extra Challenge: Can you include pictures with captions?

This year, anti-bullying week happens from 11th to 15th

November and the theme is 'Choose Respect'
