School Value Challenge:

One of our Christian values is **Hope**.

Talk with an adult about what this word means and how you might demonstrate this value.

Can you write a sentence or draw a picture about a hope or wish that you would like to achieve by the end of Year 2? How will you make sure that you get there?

English Challenge*:

On the class website you will find a poem all about Fire. We would like you to learn this poem so that you can recite it to your friends in school. You could add actions to help you remember it. You can use the poem we have provided or find your own poem based on fire.

Extra Challenge:

Can you add another verse to the poem?

Maths Challenge*:

Later this half term, we will be learning all about Length and Height. Pick 5 item from home and have a go at measuring them. You will have to think carefully about whether you will need to use a ruler or tape measure.

Extra Challenge:

Can you write some comparison sentences?

Science Challenge:

This term we have linked our Science and history learning together.

Can you design an apron for a baker. What materials will you use and why? Think about the purpose of a baker's apron.

Extra Challenge: Research what materials were used to build houses in 1666.

Art Challenge:

Create or reproduce a picture depicting a scene during the great fire including houses, smoke and flames. You could draw, paint, collage, chalk, use a computer paint package or make a shoebox model.



Spelling Challenge:

Using the Year 2 common exception word sheet on the class page pick 5 words that you think you need to practise. Have a go at learning to spell these with an adult and then write each of them.

If you did this last half term, can you pick 5 different ones?



History/Geography Challenge:

Create a map of London in 1666 showing the location of the River Thames, Pudding Lane bakery and where the fire spread. This could be drawn or collaged.



PSHE Challenge:

This half term our topic is all about 'Keeping Safe' Can you design an information poster to promote fire safety. Perhaps create a catchy slogan or advert to help people remember what to do in a fire.



RE Challenge:

In RE we are going to be looking at why Easter matters to Christians and thinking about the Easter story. Can you write a couple of sentences that describe what Easter means to you and tell us how you celebrate it, if at all.
