School Value Challenge*:

One of our school values is 'Respect'. We know that you must show respect to everybody but we would like you to think about your friends in particular.

Can you challenge yourself to show your friends respect and then record all the ways that you did this.

Eg. You said please or thank you, asked someone to play.



Writing Challenge*:

Can you write a recount of what you did in the Easter Holidays (or any exciting weekend you've had recently). Don't forget a recount is a **piece of writing that provides in detail the happenings of a previous event**. In other words, the writer is recounting what happened.

We can't wait to hear what you have been up to!

Maths Challenge*:

This half term we will be learning all about fractions! Using any small items from around your home (cubes, beads, marbles or even cheerios!) can you explore finding $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{3}$ of some amounts up to 30?

You can take pictures to show us your practical learning or record in your book like this $\frac{1}{4}$ of $16 = 4$

Challenge:

Can you find $\frac{3}{4}$ or $\frac{2}{3}$?

Science Challenge:

This term we will be looking at animals including humans – specifically offspring. Choose an animal and research how it looks after its young.

Can you tell us any interesting and unusual facts about this animal?



Art Challenge:

The artist we will be focussing on this half term is Georgia O'Keefe. One of the things she was well known for was her bright flower paintings.

Using whatever medium you have at home (pencils, felt tips, crayon...) can you draw a picture of a brightly coloured flower? Maybe look in your garden or on your walk to or from school to get some inspiration! *re.*



PSHE Challenge

This half term we are thinking about emotions. Let's think about feeling **proud**.

Can you draw a picture of the time you felt proud? You could write a few sentences to tell us a little more.

History Challenge:

Florence Nightingale will be who we will be finding out about this half term. Do you know who she is and why she was so important? Research who she was and write down some facts about her.
