What do you know about Jesus?

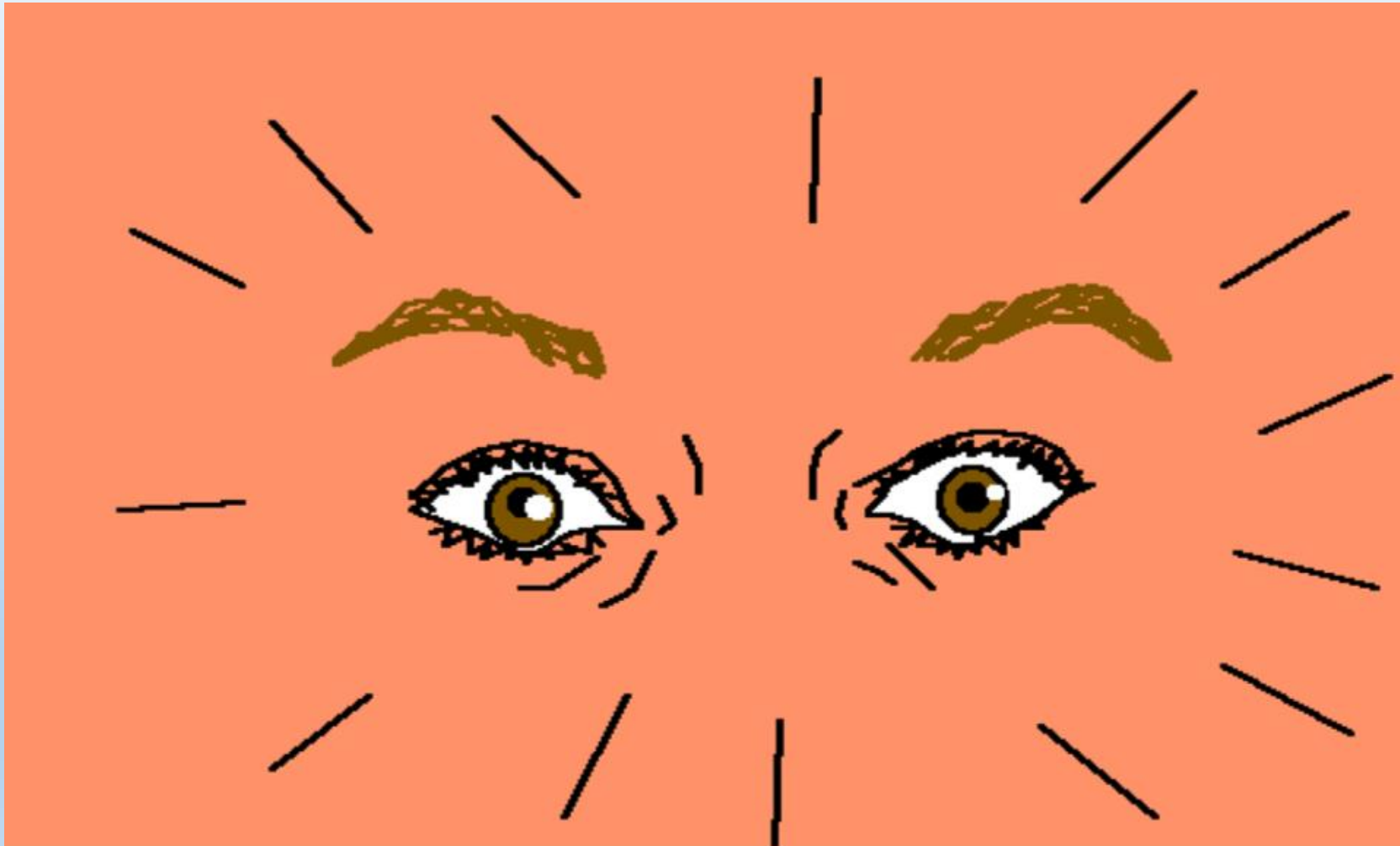
- Jesus lived a normal life working as a **carpenter** with his father Joseph until he was about 30 years old. After this, he started to **travel and teach** people about God and **what God wanted them to do**.



Christians **believe** that **Jesus did 3 main things** in this period of time:

1. **Preached** to people using parables (stories)
2. Collected **disciples** (followers to help him in his work)
3. Performed **miracles** (things that ordinary people cannot do... For example, turning water into wine).
