| <p>Science Challenge: In Year 1 you learnt the names of different parts of a plant. We would like you to refresh your memory by drawing and labelling a flower. Some labels to include are petal, leaf, stem, roots and pollen. Extra Challenge: Can you write a sentence explaining the function of one of these parts.</p> | <p>Art Challenge: This half term we are going to be drawing buildings. We would like you to have a practice before our lesson or wait until you have been taught some more skills and then have a go. You could sketch your home from the outside or why not sketch a famous building that your friends could guess. <u>Top tip</u> - Start with the shape of the building before adding any detail.</p> | <p>PSHE Challenge: This half term we are thinking about families and the communities we belong to. | <p>Geography Challenge: In Geography this half term we are going to be learning about our world. We would like you to do some research about a country you have been to or would like to go. You can choose how you present your research. E.g a booklet, poster or fact file. Include things like major cities, population, continent, flag, landmarks.</p>  | <p>PE Challenge As a school we know the importance of keeping fit and healthy! We would like you to try one of these activities with your friends and family. If you are feeling energetic you might like to complete more than one!
